## Pre-Algebra Syllabus 2019-2020

1 <sup>st</sup> Nine Weeks	Number Systems Expressions and Equations
2 <sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks	Ratios and Proportions Geometry
3 <sup>rd</sup> Nine Weeks	Probability Statistics
4 <sup>th</sup> Nine Weeks	Personal Finance Functions Scientific Notation

### Grading Policy

All Burnett Junior High School courses will average their nine weeks and semester grades according to the following criteria:

- Minor grades (quizzes, daily work) are averaged to obtain 40% of a student's nine weeks grade.
- Major grades (unit tests) are averaged to obtain 60% of a student's nine weeks grade.

### Homework

Homework is expected to be completed whenever assigned. The purpose of homework in math is to practice the skills that are learned in class with the goal of skills mastery. Our normal regiment for homework is 3-4 days per week. Homework is due at the beginning of class, the day after it is assigned.

### Attendance

Regular attendance is extremely important in Junior High and in Math. Each day in class we will build on the lesson from the previous day. It is extremely important that students be in class each and every day. However, we understand that life happens and there may be reason to occasionally miss school. In these instances, it is the student's responsibility to be sure they receive any missed assignments and come in before or after school for tutorials as needed.
